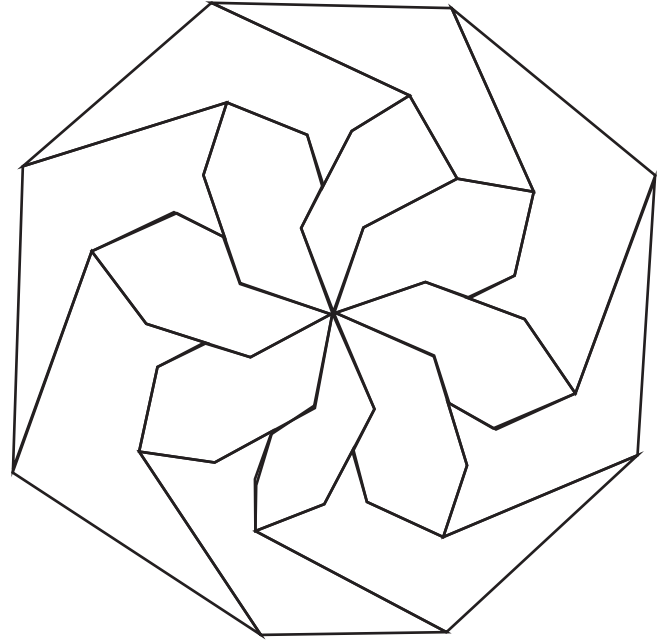
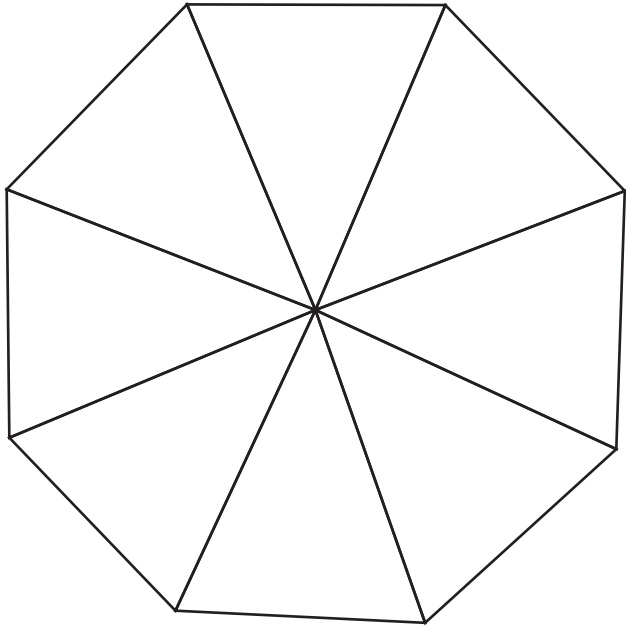


Origami Pinwheel Star

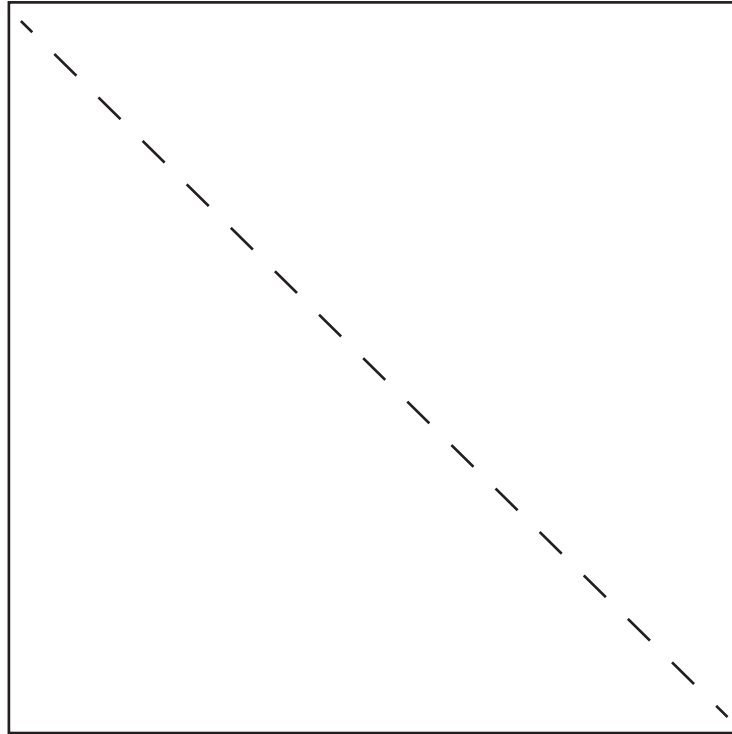

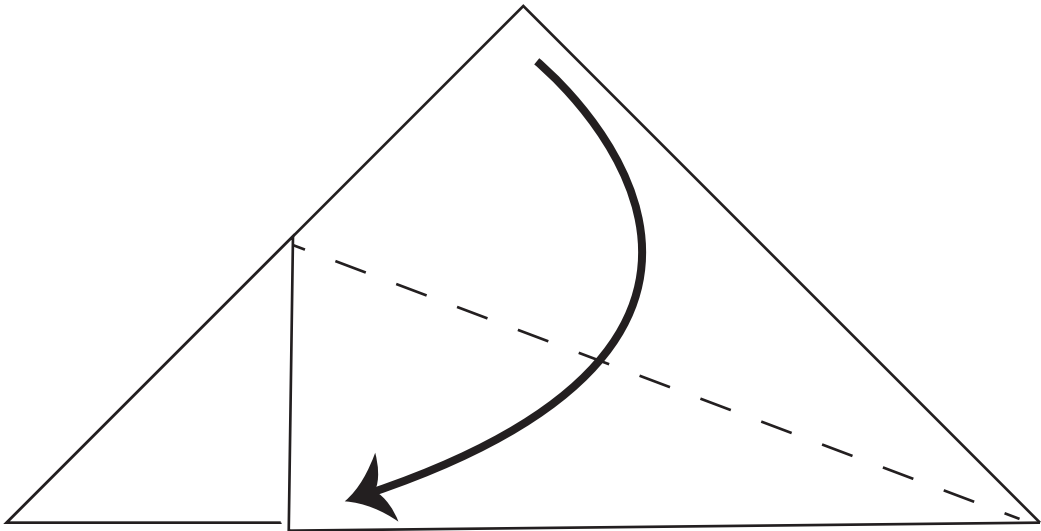
Step 1: Fold the square paper into a triangle.

Step 2: Align the top point with the bottom of the folded crease of the triangle.

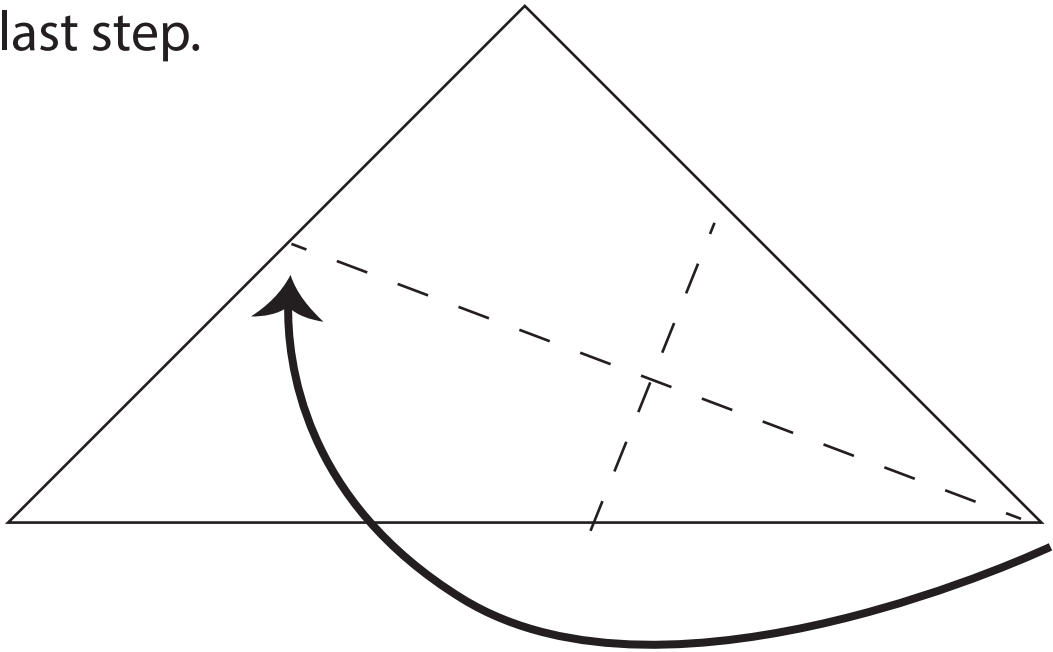


Caution: Be consistent with the side you begin folding on. All your pieces must match!

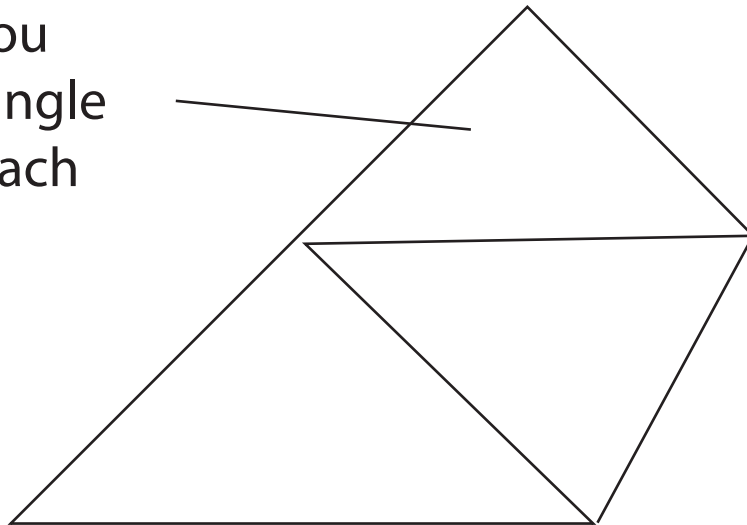

Step 3: Fold the right corner of the triangle across to where the line was created by the last step.



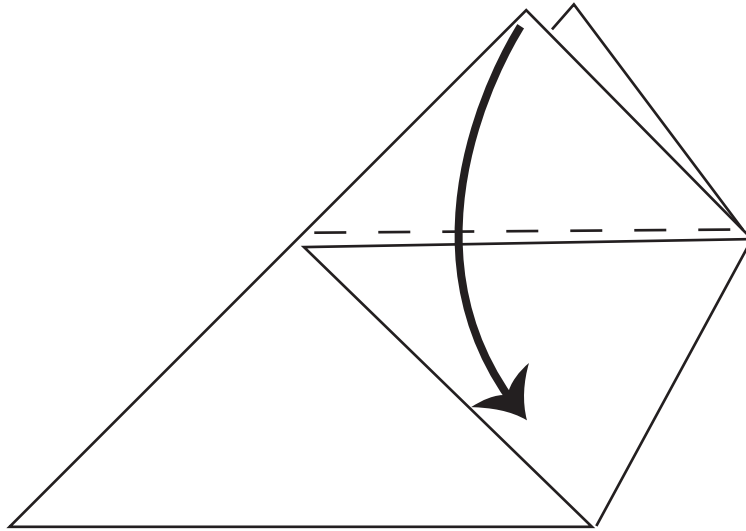
Make sure you have a nice triangle at the top of each piece.

Step 4: Fold the square paper into a triangle.

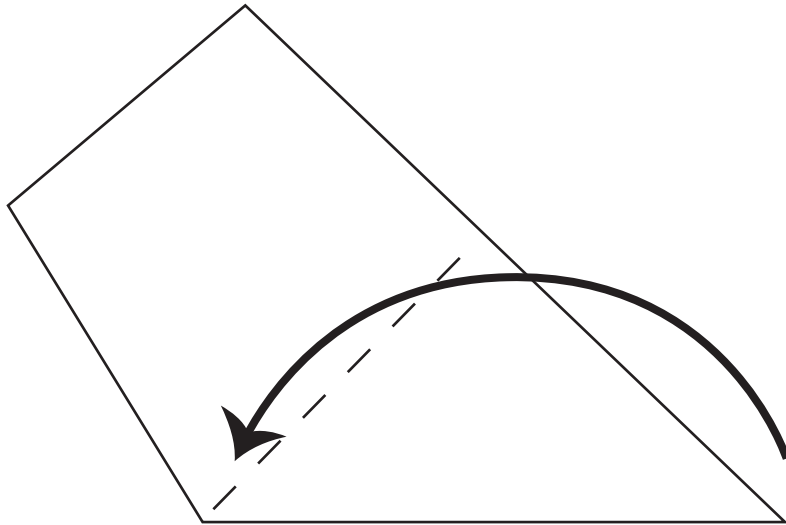


Tuck the flap into the pocket.

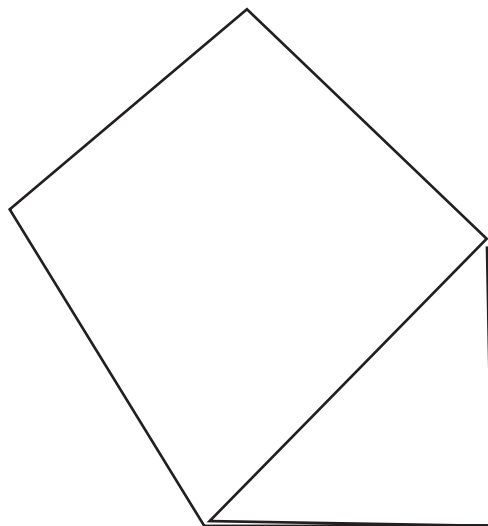

Step 5: Flip the pieces over, folded side facing the table.



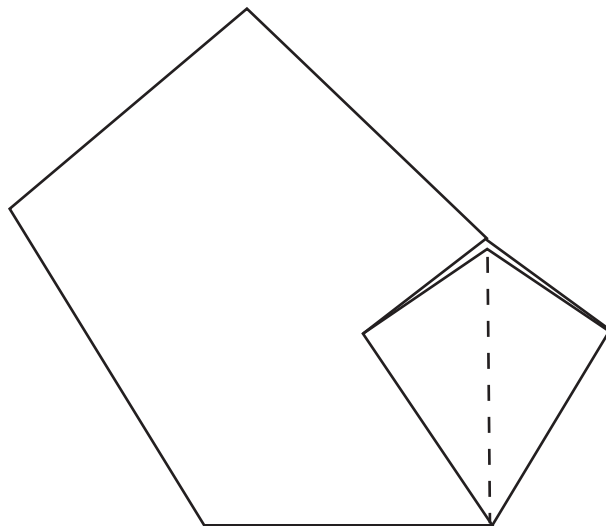
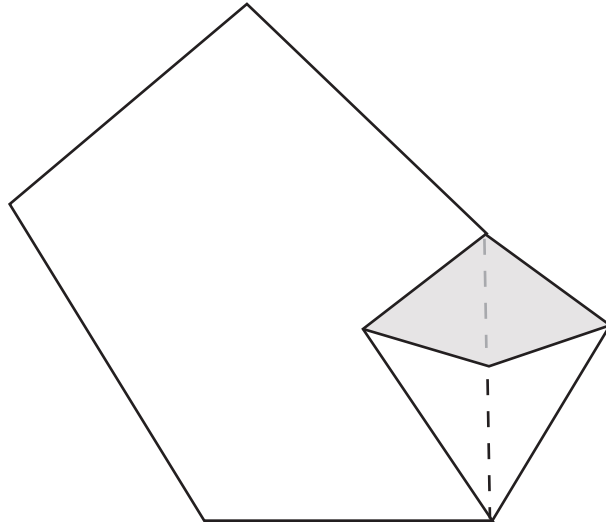
Step 6: Fold the right corner down to the bottom point. Notice the diamond shape that is created.

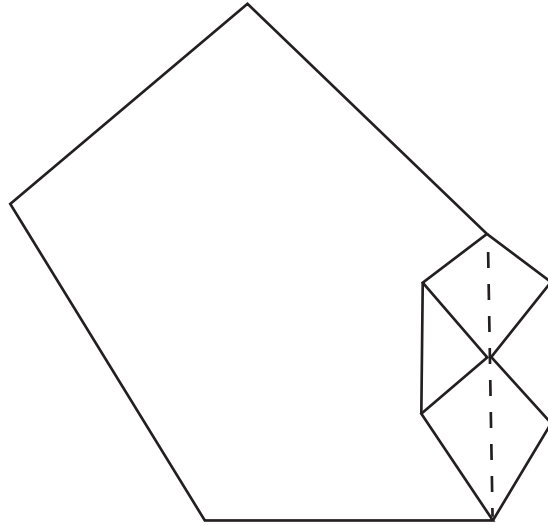

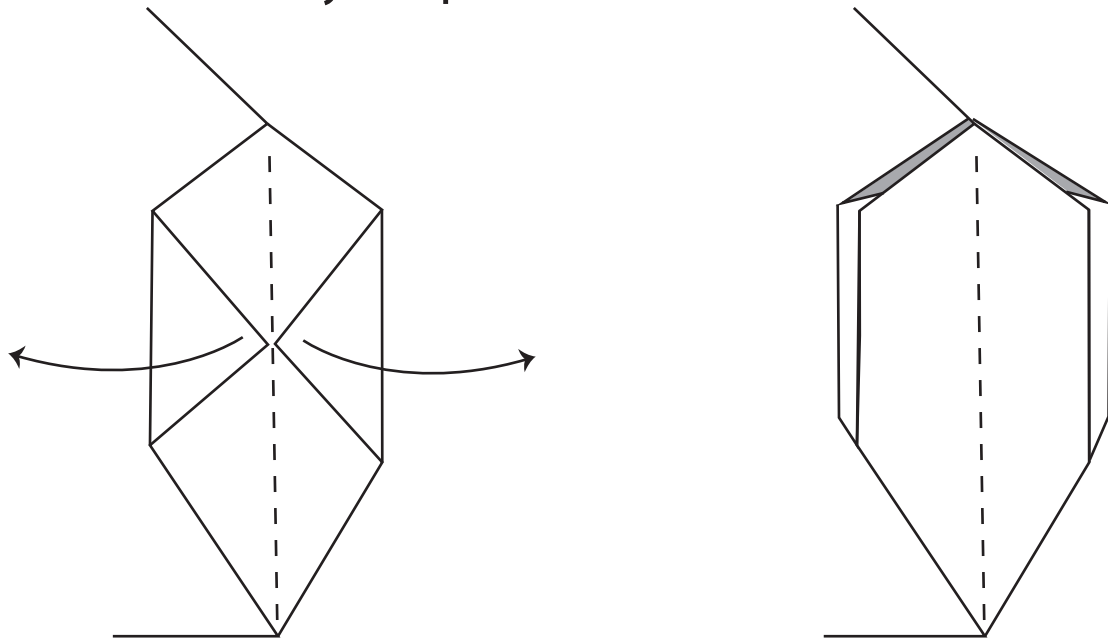

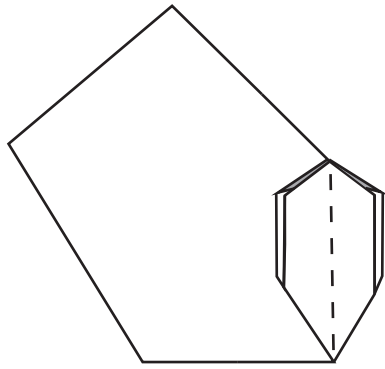
Step 9: Open the flaps

Reverse the fold by tucking the point into itself. Make the creases very crisp.

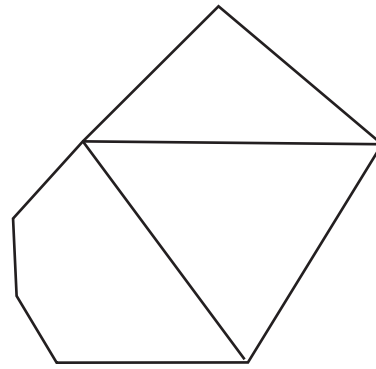

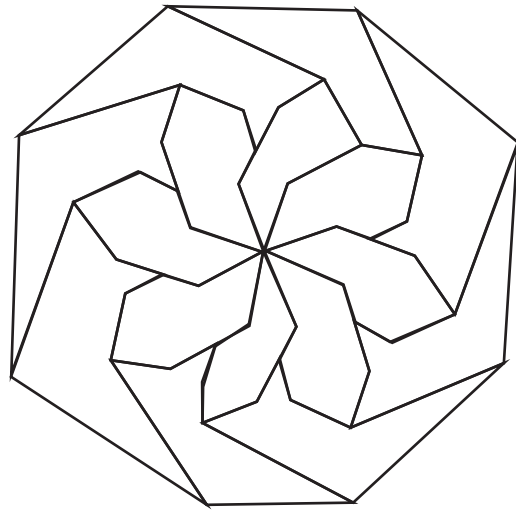
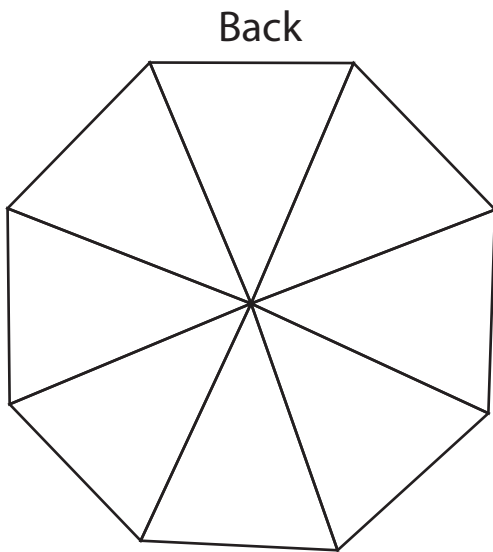
Step 10: To assemble your pinwheel, Locate the back of your pieces.

Insert the flap into the pocket on the back of the next piece.





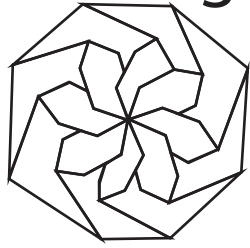
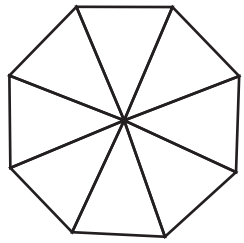

Step 11: Create an over - under pattern with the elements on the top of the pinwheel.

Add glue under the flaps.

Flatten the pinwheel under a book for a few minutes.

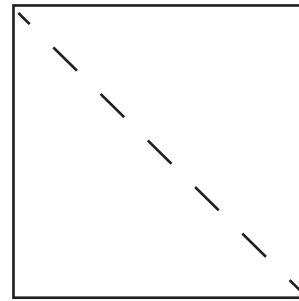
