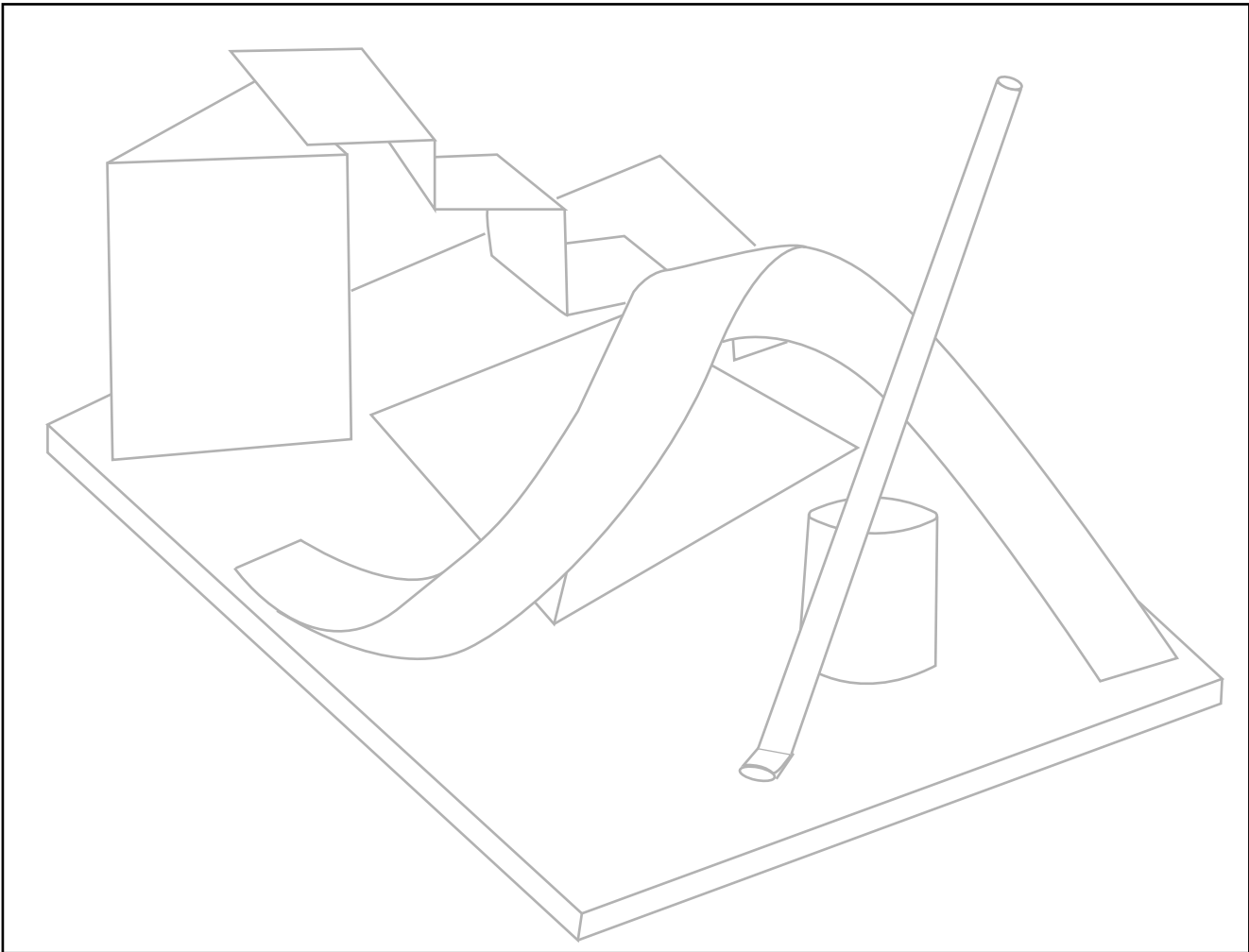
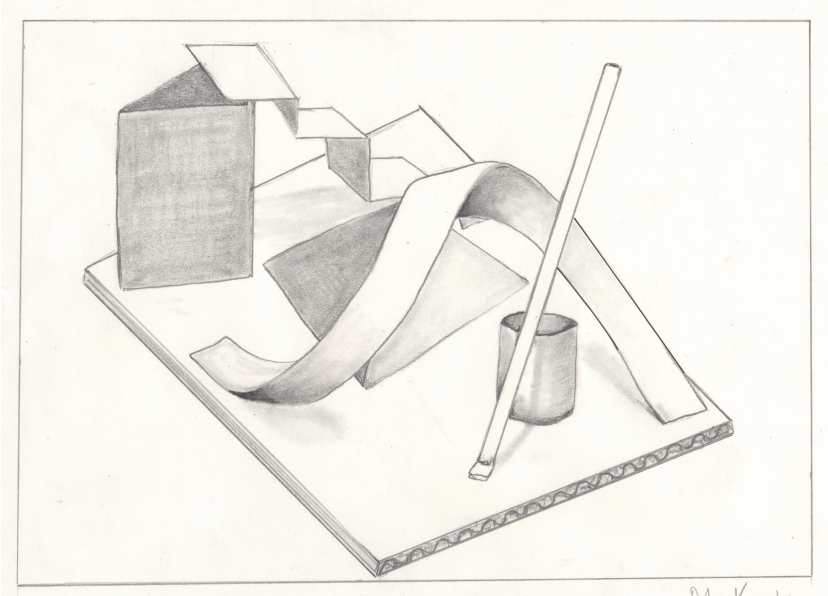


Directions - Add Value to the drawing below.

High Quality - There are light shadows to show form. All the values are softly blended from dark to light. The forms create the illusion of space

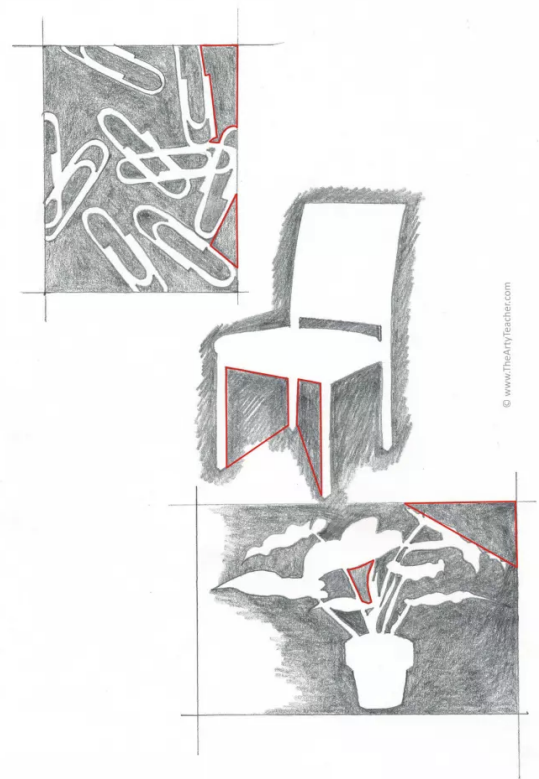
Medium Quality - The value is scribbled/not blended. There are no shadows. The forms still look flat.

Low Quality- Messy values, did not stay in the lines etc.



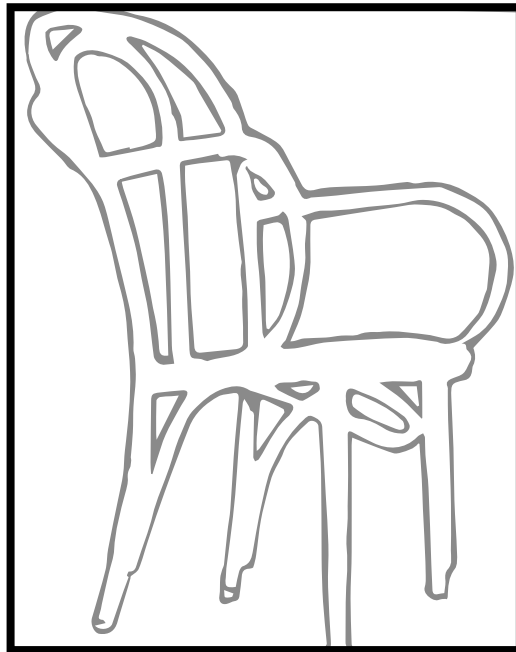
NEGATIVE SPACE - The area around or between an object

By drawing the areas that are not there (negative space) it will be easier to define what is there, with proper proportions and with a nice connections to all the parts as a whole.

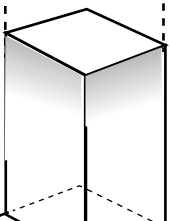

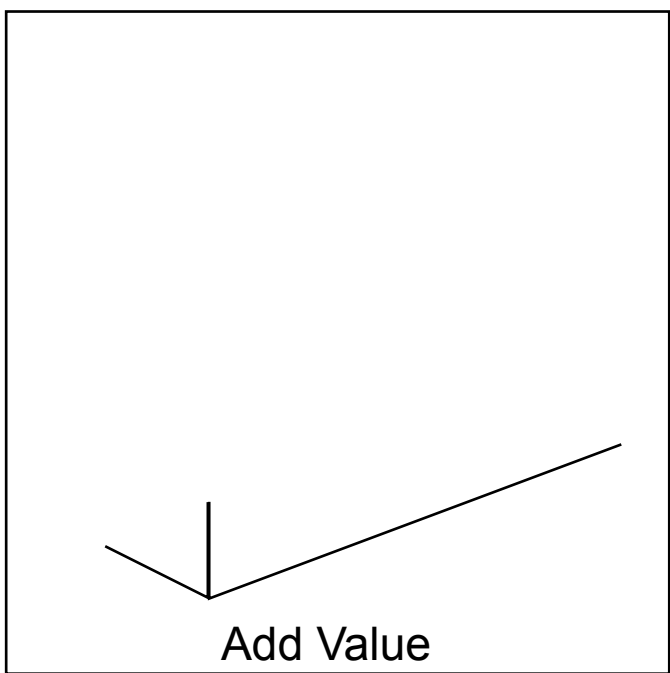

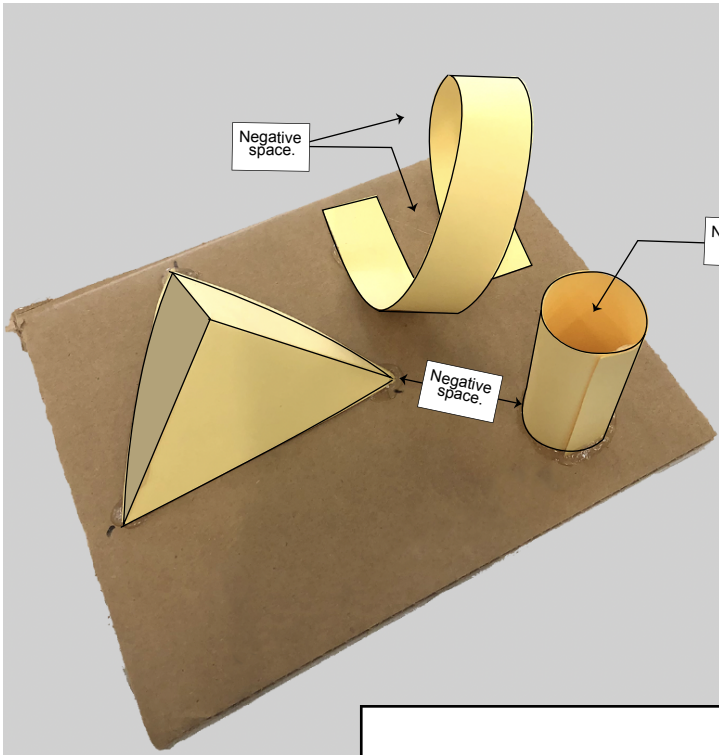
