<p>The paper hand sculpture lacks effort. There are many errors that do not create a convincing hand model. The proportions are way off.</p>	<p>The paper hand sculpture has a shape for the palm and the top of the hand, but there are errors in the shape.</p> <p>There are errors in the finger proportions. Some of the fingers do not match the measurements from the artist's hand. The thumb that has been traced and glued to the palm, but there are errors in the size or placement.</p> <p>The sculpture is missing a half circle for the wrist or it has been placed in th wrong position. The sculpture is unable to stand.</p>	<p>The paper hand sculpture has a pointed rectangle shape for the palm and the top of the hand. All the finger have proper proportions that have been measured from the artist's hand. The sculpture has a thumb that has been traced and glued to the palm. The sculpture has a half circle that has been glued to the wrist. The sculpture has a strip of cardboard that supports the sculpture to stand.</p>
<p>The drawings lack structure.</p>	<p>Some of the drawings show do not show the construction of the hand. The artist drew hands without understanding or applying a structure or formula.</p>	<p>All of the drawings show the construction of the hand. The basic shapes that make up the palm, fingers, wrist and thumb are shown.</p>
<p>The drawings lack proper proportions.</p>	<p>There are errors in the proportions, position and direction of the fingers.</p> <p>The knuckles do not curved in a rainbow line.</p>	<p>The artist was very accurate with the proportions, position and direction of the fingers.</p> <p>The knuckles are in a curved rainbow line.</p>
<p>The drawings lack proper interesting positions and effort to draw.</p>	<p>All four drawings are in different similar positions. The drawing show some effort. There is evidence that the artist gave up while attempting to draw foreshortened fingers.</p> <p>The drawing lack investigation of how the hand works.</p>	<p>All four drawings are in different positions. The drawing show a lot of effort to draw foreshortened fingers.</p> <p>Each drawing shows a unique, in-depth investigation of how the hand works.</p>
