Crane Drawing

Directions

- 1. On a 11" x 17" piece of paper draw a border that is 1" away from all the sides.
- 2. Brainstorm a concept for your composition. What story are you going to tell. What environment are your cranes in? What objects/icon can you use to help your viewer understand what is happening in your composition?
- 3. Use the packet of crane examples for your drawing. Use points to help you determine where to place the shape. Use a ruler to connect your points with a straight line.
- 4. Your composition must have at least 5 individual cranes in different positions.
- 5. You must use color to shade in the cranes. Use darker colors to show where the folds are behind. See examples for clarification.
