There are colors straight from the watercolor palette.</p> <p>The artist left some circles or the background without color.</p> <p>The artist rushed through the assignment. The level of quality could be improved.</p>	<p>10 pts.</p> <p>There is evidence that the artist mixed all their colors. There are no colors straight from the watercolor palette.</p> <p>The artist filled each circle and the background with a completely different color that was mixed.</p> <p>The artist showed craftsmanship and a very high level of quality.</p>
